How often can I vote?

You can enter one submission per email address per 24 hour period.

I teach at the College-level. Can I win?

Unfortunately, only K-12 schools and their teachers are eligible to participate in the Technology in Education Grant. Keep your eyes open for a College giveaway in the near future!

I'm a teacher. How can I get my students to vote for me?

Download the Technology in Education Grant flyer. You can print it off to send home with your students or upload it to your class website. The flyer will give them all the information they need to nominate you.

When will the winners be announced?

The final day for voting is March 31st. Winners will be verified for eligibility and announced within one week of the contest end date.

If my school wins a grant, how can we use the money?

The winning school must use the grant to advance technology integration in their school.

My school isn't on your list. Can I still vote?

Yes! There is a location on the survey form where you can manually input your school.

My child attends a private school. Is his/her teacher eligible?

Yes, teachers who are employed at public, private or parochial schools are eligible.

How old do you have to be to vote?

Voting is open to anyone 13 years of age and older.
